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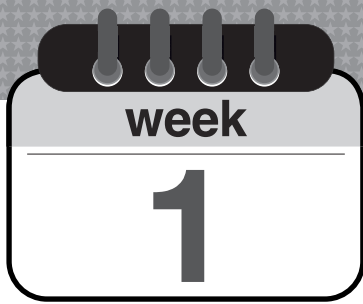

- ▶ *n.* 嬰兒

- ▶ *n.* 情侶;夫妻;(一)對
Sam and Jenny are a nice **couple**. They have been together for three years.

- ▶ *n.* 顧客
The **customer** went to the counter to pay for the meal.

I have a **guest** staying at my house.

I see my **neighbor** every morning. We leave our houses around the same time.

- ▶ *n.* 搭檔;夥伴;配偶
Kelly is my **partner** for the science project. We will work together on it.

[ˈpɜːsn]

- ▶ *n.* 人;人稱
A **person** I did not know asked me for the time.

10 **teenager**
[ˈtiːn,edʒə]

- ▶ *n.* 青少年
Linda's 13th birthday is next month. She will be a **teenager** soon.

- ▶ *adj.* 肥胖的;厚實的
n. 脂肪
Harry is **fat** because he eats too much fast food.

3 **old**
[old]

- ▶ *adj.* 年老的;古老的
My grandmother may look **old**, but she has a young heart.
我的奶奶可能看起來年紀很大，但她有顆年輕的心。

4 **short**
[ʃɔːrt]

- ▶ *adj.* 矮的;短的;短暫的;缺乏的
The boy is too **short** to see out the window.
那個男孩太矮，無法看到窗外。

5 **tall**
[tɔːl]

- ▶ *adj.* 高的;高大的;有...高的
If you want to play basketball, it helps if you are **tall**.
如果你想要打籃球，身材高大對你會有幫助。

6 **thin**
[θɪn]

- ▶ *adj.* 瘦的;薄的;稀薄的
My cat is a little **thin**. He doesn't eat very much.
我的貓有點瘦，牠的食量不大。

慣用語

on thin ice 如履薄冰(比喻處境危險)

- ▶ Be careful, you are **on thin ice**.

小心，你現在如履薄冰。

[ˈʌɡli]
- ▶ *adj.* 醜陋的;難看的;可憎的
I don't like that shirt. It is so **ugly**.
我不喜歡那件襯衫,它很難看。

- 8 **young**
[jʌŋ]
- ▶ *adj.* 年輕的;幼小的;年輕人的
Young people love to play video games.
年輕人喜歡玩電動。
-
- 9 **angry**
[ˈæŋɡri]
- ▶ *adj.* 生氣的;憤怒的
Gina is very **angry**. She doesn't want to talk to me.
Gina 非常生氣,她不想跟我講話。

- 10 **bored**
[bɔrd]
- ▶ *adj.* 使人無聊的;令人厭倦的
There is nothing to do today. I am so **bored**.
今天沒有什麼事情好做,我好無聊。

- 11 **brave**
[breɪv]
- ▶ *adj.* 勇敢的;無畏的
The **brave** little boy is not afraid of the dark.
那個勇敢的小男孩不怕黑。

[ˈbɪzi]
- ▶ *adj.* 忙碌的;繁忙的
Julia can't come to the party because she is **busy**.
Julia 沒辦法來派對,因為她太忙了。

[ˈklevə]
- ▶ *adj.* 聰明的;靈巧的
Tom is a very **clever** student. He always does well on tests.
Tom 是位非常聰明的學生,他考試總是考得很好。

[ˈkɒnfədənt]
- ▶ *adj.* 自信的;確信的
I was very **confident** I would pass the test because I studied hard for it.

- ▶ *adj.* 瘋狂的;狂熱的
My brother is **crazy** about baseball.

- ▶ *adj.* 邪惡的;惡毒的
n. 邪惡
The **evil** man laughed while his neighbor's house burnt down.

[ɪkˈsaɪtɪd]
- ▶ *adj.* 興奮的
Johnny is **excited** about the summer vacation.
Johnny 興奮期待著暑假的到來。

- 18 **famous**
[ˈfeɪməs]
- ▶ *adj.* 出名的;著名的
She is a **famous** singer. Everyone knows her songs.
她是位知名歌手,大家都知道她的歌。

[ˈfrendli]
- ▶ *adj.* 友善的;令人愉快的
Jane is a **friendly** person. She says hello to everyone she meets.

20 **funny**
[ˈfʌni]

- ▶ *adj.* 有趣的;滑稽的
The **funny** clown made the children happy.
那個滑稽的小丑把孩子們逗得很開心。

21 **jealous**
[ˈdʒeləs]

- ▶ *adj.* 妒忌的;善妒的
If you talk to Ray, his girlfriend will get **jealous**.
如果你和 Ray 說話，他的女朋友會吃醋。

22 **kind**
[kaɪnd]

- ▶ *adj.* 親切的;寬容的
n. 種類
Danny is a **kind** man. He always helps people in need.
Danny 對人很好，他總是協助有需要的人。

23 **lazy**
[ˈleɪzi]

- ▶ *adj.* 懶散的;悠閒的
Wake up! It's already 10 o'clock. Don't be **lazy**.
醒醒呀!已經十點了，別這麼懶惰。

24 **naughty**
[ˈnɔ:ti]

- ▶ *adj.* 頑皮的;不守規矩的
The boy is being **naughty** so his mother is angry with him.
男孩調皮搗蛋，所以他的媽媽在生他的氣。

25 **polite**
[pəˈlaɪt]

- ▶ *adj.* 有禮貌的
It isn't **polite** to talk when you have food in your mouth.
口中有食物時說話是不禮貌的。

26 **poor**
[pʊr]

- ▶ *adj.* 貧窮的
Mike doesn't have any money. He is very **poor**.
Mike 沒有錢，他很窮。

27 **rich**
[rɪtʃ]

- ▶ *adj.* 有錢的
The **rich** man lives in a big house.
那個有錢人住在大房子裡。

慣用語 **from rags to riches** 白手起家;由窮致富

- ▶ Peter used to be poor and now he has a lot of money. He went **from rags to riches**.

28 **shy**
[ʃaɪ]

- ▶ *adj.* 害羞的
My son is very **shy**. He won't even look at people he doesn't know.
我的兒子非常害羞，他甚至不敢看陌生人。

29 **smart**
[smɑ:t]

- ▶ *adj.* 聰明的;機靈的;時髦的
If you don't know the answer, then ask your father. He is a very **smart** man.
如果你不知道答案，那麼問你爸爸，他很聰明。

30 **stupid**
[ˈstju:pɪd]

- ▶ *adj.* 愚笨的;糊塗的
Getting the train ticket at the last minute was a **stupid** idea. They're all sold out now.

31 **unhappy**
[ʌn`hæpɪ]

- ▶ *adj.* 不高興的; 不滿意的; 悲傷的
Lisa is very **unhappy** today because she had a fight with her friend.
Lisa 今天非常不開心，因為她和朋友吵架了。

1 **chin**
[tʃɪn]

- ▶ *n.* 下巴
You have a little soup on your **chin**. Here's a napkin to wipe it off.
你的下巴上有一點湯汁，這裡有餐巾可以擦掉。

2 **ear**
[ɪr]

- ▶ *n.* 耳朵
Melanie doesn't hear well out of her left **ear**.
Melanie 左耳的聽力不太好。

慣用語 **The walls have ears.** 隔牆有耳。

- ▶ Shhh! Don't talk about it now. **The walls have ears.**
噓！別說了。隔牆有耳。

3 **eye**
[aɪ]

- ▶ *n.* 眼睛
Johnny has beautiful brown **eyes**.
Johnny 有漂亮的棕色雙眼。

慣用語 **An eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth.**

- 以牙還牙，以眼還眼。
▶ He hit me so I hit him back. It was **an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth**.
他打我，所以我還擊回去。這就是以牙還牙，以眼還眼。

4 **face**
[fes]

- ▶ *n.* 臉; 面子
v. 面對
Simon turned his **face** to the camera.
Simon 將臉轉過去面對相機。

5 **hair**
[hɛr]

- ▶ *n.* 頭髮; 毛髮
Jenny brushes her long **hair** every night.
Jenny 每天晚上梳她的長髮。

6 **mouth**
[mauθ]

- ▶ *n.* 嘴; 口腔
You should cover your **mouth** when you cough.
你咳嗽時應該要摀嘴巴。

7 **nose**
[noz]

- ▶ *n.* 鼻子
Gary has a runny **nose**. I guess he has a cold.
Gary 在流鼻涕，我猜他感冒了。

- 8 **arm**
[ɑrm] ▶ *n.* 手臂; 扶手
My **arm** hurts after playing tennis for an hour.
我跌倒且傷了手臂。

- 9 **back**
[bæk] ▶ *n.* 背; 背部; 後面
Alan likes to sleep on his **back**. He never sleeps on his side.
Alan 喜歡仰睡，他從不側睡。

- 10 **body**
[ˈbɒdɪ] ▶ *n.* (人、動物) 身體; 屍體
I like to go swimming. It makes my **body** feel great.
我喜歡去游泳，能讓我通體舒暢。

- 11 **hip**
[hɪp] ▶ *n.* 臀部; 屁股
You have to move your **hips** when you dance.
你跳舞的時候要動一動臀部。
-
- 12 **shoulder**
[ˈʃɒldə] ▶ *n.* 肩膀; 肩部
The men were standing in a line with their **shoulders** touching.
男士們肩並肩站成一列。
-
- 13 **throat**
[θrɒt] ▶ *n.* 喉嚨
I have been singing too much so my **throat** hurts.
我唱了太多歌，所以喉嚨痛。

- 14 **wrist**
[rɪst] ▶ *n.* 手腕
Tom wears a gold watch on his left **wrist**.
Tom 的左手腕上戴了一只金錶。

- 15 **stomach**
[ˈstʌmək] ▶ *n.* 胃; 肚子
I think I ate something bad. My **stomach** really hurts.
我想我吃到壞掉的食物了，我的胃好痛。

- 1 **comfortable**
[ˈkʌmfə-təbəl] ▶ *adj.* 舒適的; 舒服的; 自在的
I don't feel **comfortable**. I think I had better lie down.
我覺得不舒服，我想我最好躺下來。

- 2 **dizzy**
[ˈdɪzi] ▶ *adj.* 頭暈目眩的
This car ride is making me **dizzy**. Please stop the car.
這趟車程讓我頭暈，請把車子停下來。
-
- 3 **painful**
[ˈpeɪnfəl] ▶ *adj.* 令人痛苦的
It was very **painful** when my tooth was pulled out.
拔牙痛死我了。

- 4 **sick**
[sɪk] ▶ *adj.* 生病的;不舒服的;噁心想吐的
Steve is **sick** so he won't come to school today.
Steve 生病了,所以他今天不會來上學。
- 5 **well**
[wɛl] ▶ *adj.* 健康的;好的
adv. 很好地;完全地;非常地
Jerry will come back to school when he gets **well**.
當 Jerry 恢復健康,他就會回來上學。
- 6 **headache**
[ˈhɛd,ek] ▶ *n.* 頭痛;令人頭痛的事
Can you turn down the music? It's giving me a **headache**.
你能否把音樂轉小聲?它讓我頭痛。
- 7 **fever**
[ˈfivə] ▶ *n.* 發燒;狂熱
Touch my head. I think I have a **fever**.
你摸摸我的頭,我想我發燒了。
- 8 **cure**
[kjʊr] ▶ *n.* 藥物;治療方式
v. 治療
Doctors are trying to find a **cure** for every disease.
醫生們正試圖找出每種疾病的治療方法。
- 9 **medicine**
[ˈmɛdɪsn] ▶ *n.* 藥物;醫學
I don't like to take this **medicine** because it tastes so bad.
我不喜歡吃這個藥,因為它很難吃。

- ▶ Now you know what it feels like when people are mean to you. I gave you **a taste of your own medicine**.

- 1 **Dr. = doctor**
[ˈdaktə] ▶ *n.* 醫生;博士
Good morning, **Dr.** Jones. I wanted to ask you about a pain in my left arm.
Jones 醫師早安,我想要請教你我左手臂的疼痛是怎麼回事。
- 2 **Mr. = mister**
[ˈmɪstə] ▶ *n.* 先生
This is **Mr.** Katz. He will show you around the office.
這位是 Katz 先生,他會帶你走一趟辦公室。
- 3 **Mrs. = mistress**
[ˈmɪsɪz] ▶ *n.* 夫人;太太
I am **Mrs.** Wilson, but you can call me by my first name, Maggie.
我是 Wilson 太太,但你可以用我的名字 Maggie 來稱呼我。
- 4 **Miss**
[mɪs] ▶ *n.* 女士;小姐(尤指未婚女子)
Miss Taylor is our English teacher.
Taylor 小姐是我們的英文老師。

I will look after my **nephew** this weekend.

- Could I please borrow **eighty** dollars? I'll pay you back next week.
